PROGRAM FEES

2012-2013

All students at Berkeley Adult School will be charged fees as follows:

Adult Basic Education (ABE), Adult Secondary Education (ASE)(GED and HS Diploma), students will pay a \$35 non-refundable registration fee each semester prior to assessment testing.

<u>English as a Second Language</u> (ESL) students will pay a \$45 non-refundable registration fee for each class each semester prior to assessment testing.

Older Adult students will pay a \$35 non-refundable fee per class per semester. These fees will be submitted with the completed registration forms for these classes.

<u>Adults with Disabilities</u> (or Frail elders) <u>Program</u> course fees will be paid by the institution at which the classes are held.

Career Technical Education [CTE] students will pay different fees based on the type of program. The CTE Program, in accordance with Perkins Grant requirements and CDE guidance, will emphasize and focus on student completion of career pathways: Allied Health Careers (Administrative [front office] Medical Assistant, CNA, LVN, and EMT), Software Applications (Microsoft certifications) and Accounting, and Graphic Arts Applications. There are no fee waivers. Prospective CTE students are encouraged to go through local One Stop Centers for referral and payment to Berkeley Adult School's CTE programs. If there is insufficient student enrollment prior to the start of a class, the class may be canceled.

<u>Community Service or Fee Based Classes</u> are offered at a cost to cover teachers' salaries, direct and indirect costs. If there is insufficient student enrollment prior to the start of a class, the class will be canceled if the minimum number of students is not reached two days before the first class session.
